Perder uma rainha de concurso pode ser considerado um infortúnio; perder dois parece negligência. Dois dias depois de Miss EUA deixou o papel citando problemas médicos, a Sra. Teen BR também se curvou na quarta-feira a quina está acumulada um post no Instagram que foi vencedor do concurso da Sra Adolescente nos Estados Unidos UmaSofia Srivastava disse: "Os seus valores pessoais já não estão totalmente alinhados com as orientações desta organização". A renúncia de Srivastava, que veio tão logo após a partida da Noelia Voigt como Miss EUA s. O mistério do duplo abandono foi aumentado pelas palavras separáveis das mulheres Srivastava, que foi coroada Miss Teen BR a quina está acumulada setembro de 2007, tendo representado Nova Jersey ndia e encabeçado a quina está acumulada nota no Instagram com uma citação do filósofo Friedrich Nietzsche. O alemão tem sido acusado por muitas coisas - algumas delas lamentável mas amante dos concursos não é um deles! "Não há superfícies bonitas sem uma profundidade terrível", foi a citação de Nietzsche que Srivastava intrigantemente selecionou. A assinatura do Instagram de Voigt foi ainda mais sombriamente encriptada; Possivelmente emulando o notório truque da escritora frequentemente usado por jornalistas que partiam para atirar com um snipe na a quina está acumulada editora não amada, a voiget começou cada uma das primeiras 11 frases desta nota.

Após as demissões duplas, o apoio foi derramado para duas mulheres nas mídias sociais. Cada uma abriu novos caminhos com suas diversas origens
Voigt, da Flórida é um venezuelano americano. Srivastava se auto-identifica como mexicano indiano nascido do México

O executivo-chefe da Miss EUA e a Sra. Teen USA, Laylah Rose disse ao New York Times que seu objetivo nas marcas era "celebrar as mulheres". Ela prometeu fornecer "passos verdadeiramente úteis podemos tomar juntos", sem especificar o quê eles poderiam ser ".
Três semanas atrás, a Miss EUA anunciou no Instagram que havia revisado a quina está acumulada abordagem de mídia social. Para garantir o chamado "conteúdo consistente" a quina está acumulada ambos os Estados Unidos e na Sra Teen BR disse ele - as postagens seriam controladas pela organização do evento não pelos vencedores individuais dos concursos "Nossos titulares foram informados antes dessa mudança, uma vez que a decisão foi finalizada", disse Miss USA.
