Andrii Novak Helps Himself toR\$91K Score on GGPoker

Ukrainian superstar Andrii Novak helped himself to aR\$91,016 prize at GGPoker this weekend, his reward for coming out on top of a 1,981-strong field in theR\$525 Bounty Hunters HR Main Event.

Half theR\$1 million prize pool went onto the heads of all the entrants in the form of a progressive bounty. The remaining 50% was shared among the top 278 finishers.

All nine finalists locked up five-figure prizes when bounties were included. "JustaMortal" was the first of those nine finalists to fall by the wayside. "Fangio", Aleks Trofimov, and "JoaoSymon" followed that early casualty to the rail.

Polish sensation Dominik Panka ran out of steam in fifth-place, a finish worthR\$23,800 in total. Possible Breaking Bad fan "HEIZENBERG\_G" was the fourth-place finisher and bankedR\$35,975.

Heads-up was set when "BocaRosa" fell in third forR\$32,726. This left Novak heads-up against "Bcb20" of Turkey. Novak brushed aside his opponent and saw a massiveR\$91,016 head to his GGPoker account, thanks to the nearR\$50,000 bounty payment. The runner-up walked away withR\$59,415 reasons to be proud of their performance.

David Coleman Comes Out On Top in the Sunday 500 High Rollers

David Coleman spends most of his time crushing US-facing online poker site but

he headed to Canada so he could play at GGPoker. It proved to be a fantastic decision because he won the Sunday 500 High Rollers and helped himself to a R\$125,383 reward.

It

was a compact field of 108 entrants but a field that contained some of the biggest names from the poker world. Plenty of those names navigated their way to the final table, including Anatoly Filatov (9th -R\$14,176), Fedor Holz (8th -R\$18,616), Joaquim Andersson (7th -R\$24,447), and David Yan (6th -R\$32,105).

Mexico's "TheRayGuy" (5th

-R\$42,160) and Estonia's "bungakat" (4th -R\$55,365) were the next to fall, which left Coleman to contest with Jason Koon and Nick Petrangelo three-handed, which isn't the nicest spot to be in.

Coleman not only held his own but shone brightly, and emerged a worthy champion. Petrangelo crashed out in third for R\$72,706, while Koon collected R\$95,478 for his exit in second. Coleman was the man of the event and we're sure he'll put the R\$125,383 prize to good use.

Aleksejs Ponakovs is the latest superstar to take down the High Roller Big Game at partypoker. ThisR\$2,600 buy-in event always attracts stellar names, and this week was no different. Just look at the nine finalists from the 128 starters.

Roberto

Romanello finished in ninth forR\$8,827, which left the remaining players to book in a prize worth five-figures.

Bujtas Laszlo, Matthias Eibinger, and David Yan joined

Romanello on the sidelines with Yan securing aR\$14,814 payout.

Ami Barer crashed and

burned in fifth before Team partypoker pro Patrick Leonard busted in fourth for aR\$24,950 addition to his bankroll. Leonard's fellow Brit Ashley Windsor exited in third forR\$35,286 to set up a mouth-watering one-on-one battle between Ponakovs and Elio Fox.

The heads-up match could have gone either way but it was Ponakovs who emerged victoriously once the dust settled. This resulted in Ponakovs collectingR\$79,925 and Fox theR\$51,428 runner-up prize.

888poker Sunday Sale Proves a Major  
Hit

888poker  
888poker ran its Sunday Sale promotion on February 21 resulting in a handful of the site's most popular Sunday tournaments having their buy-ins slashed.

The R\$100,000 Sunday Sale Mega Deep was one such tournament. Some 2,092 players bought in for the bargain price of R\$55 to ensure those who finished in the money shared R\$104,600.

"MrSweden" finished at the top of the pile and turned their R\$55 into R\$17,666 after defeating Argentina's "TheFreston" heads-up. The Argentinian collected R\$12,572, the tournament's only other five-figure prize.

The R\$30,000 Sunday Sale Whale ended in a heads-up chop between "mylly8" of Finland and "cherrywine" of Pakistan. That deal saw the former scoop R\$8,016 and the latter R\$7,597 for their R\$215 investment.

Brazil's "IneedDrinho" was the last player standing in the R\$30,000 Sunday Challenge PKO. They banked R\$7,595 for their impressive victory, which was made up of a R\$4,696 top prize and R\$2,898 worth of bounty payments.

Michel "FreeLancerZZ" Dattani Wins Turbo  
Series High Roller

Michel Dattani  
Michel "FreeLancerZZ" Dattani won the Turbo Series 03: R\$5,200 NLHE 8-Max High Roller event and walked away with a massive R\$152,743 prize. Dattani's haul would have been R\$15,000 more had he not struck a deal with Russia's "CrazyLissy" when heads-up; CrazyLissy banked R\$144,863.

The rest of the final table read like a who's who of the poker world, as you'd expect for a R\$5,200 buy-in.

Rui  
"RuiNF" Ferreira and Juan "Malaka\$tle" Pardo were the final table's first casualties before Yuri "theNERDguy" Dzivielevski and David "MissOracle" Yan ran out of steam, the latter locking up R\$61,471.

Joni "bustoville" Jouhkimainen dusted his stack off in fourth, which netted him the tournament's last five-figure prize, namely R\$78,959.

Jon  
"apestyles" Van Fleet busted in third-place for R\$101,421, before Dattani and CrazyLissy struck the aforementioned deal to conclude the event.

## **Rishi Sunak renuncia como líder conservador y primer ministro en medio de la derrota electoral del partido**

Rishi Sunak ha anunciado su renuncia como líder del Partido Conservador y primer ministro del Reino Unido, luego de la aplastante derrota de su partido frente al Partido Laborista en las elecciones generales.

Sunak se reunirá con el rey para oficializar su renuncia y dar paso a Keir Starmer para asumir el cargo de primer ministro en Downing Street.

Su decisión de renunciar como líder conservador desencadenará otra carrera por el liderazgo del partido, en un intento por reconstruirse después de un resultado devastador. Sunak se mantendrá como líder del partido hasta que se realicen los arreglos necesarios para encontrar un

reemplazo.

Sunak asumió el cargo en octubre de 2024 sin oposición, luego del colapso de la breve gestión de Liz Truss en Downing Street. Ha prometido permanecer como diputado durante el plazo completo del actual parlamento.
