What is Short Deck Poker?

Short-deck poker (also known as six-plus hold'em) is a new variation of traditional Texas hold'em that mostly follows the same rules albeit with a significant difference.

Short-deck poker uses a smaller 36-card deck rather than the full 52-card deck.

Most first heard of short-deck poker after it was introduced among the mix in the high-stakes cash games in Macau.

Short-Deck Poker Rules

Before we discover how to play short-deck poker, let's see how to get to the 36-card deck needed to play a game of 6+ hold'em.

The 36-card deck in use in poker short deck is created by removing the 2xs, 3xs, 4xs, and 5xs from the deck (16 cards).

That leaves the 6xs up through the Kxs as well as the Axs.

What about the Aces?

As in regular hold'em, in short-deck poker the aces still count as high or low when making straights.

The lowest possible straight in a game of short-deck poker is Ax9x8x7x6x (think of the ace as essentially replacing the missing 5x).

Poker short-deck is played similarly to regular hold'em.

Each player receive two hole cards and use them in combination with five community cards to create the best possible hand.

A game of short-deck poker features four streets of betting:

Pre-flop Flop Turn River

However, there are some differences in the poker short-deck poker that you should know about before playing.

Short-Deck Poker Hand Rankings

Short-deck poker can be played according to the exact same rules as regular Texas Hold'em.

The betting can be fixed-limit or no-limit (although most often the game is played no-limit), and the same hand rankings can be used as follows:

Alternative Short-Deck Hand Rankings

Short-deck poker is played often employing a different hand ranking system. Here are the alternate hand rankings for short-deck poker (note the differences in bold):

As you can see, following these alternate poker short deck hand rankings a three-of-a-kind beats a straight (instead of vice-versa), and a flush beats a full house (instead of vice-versa).

Why a Different Hand Rankings?

These changes were introduced because the removal of cards from the standard deck alter the probabilities of making certain hands.

For example, with only nine suited cards (instead of 13), a flush is harder to make in short-deck poker than in regular hold'em.

Six-Plus Hold'em Variation — The Deal (Fifth Street)

One other popular variation often introduced in six-plus hold'em has to do with the way the river is dealt.

The game can be played according to the same procedure followed in regular hold'em, with the community cards coming in the same way — flop (three cards), turn (one card), and river (one card) — and betting rounds after each street.

More often, though, instead of a river card being dealt to complete a five-card board, players are each dealt a third hole card instead.

Players then make their five-card poker hands by using exactly two of their three hole cards and three of the four community cards.

The building of hands resembles the procedure followed in Omaha poker where players must use two of their four hole cards plus three board cards to make a five-card poker hand.

Short-Deck Poker Basic Strategy

As you might imagine, the removal of low cards and use of the 36-card deck makes it more likely to make higher value hands, a change that tends to introduce more action.

You should adjust your thinking about relative hand values from what they are used to in regular hold'em.

The smaller deck makes it easier to make two-pair hands, which means a hand like top pair-top kicker is no longer as strong in six-plus hold'em as it is in regular hold'em.

Straights and full houses are also easier to make in six-plus hold'em than in the regular version of the game (a reason for the alternate hand rankings).

The odds of hitting certain draws change, too, in short-deck poker.

Just to highlight one example, filling an open-ended straight draw becomes more likely in poker short-deck.

While you're still looking for the same eight outs there are fewer total cards in the deck, thus increasing the percentage you'll make your straight.

The smaller deck also affects the likelihood of being dealt certain hands. [You're more than twice as likely to get pocket aces] in short-deck poker than you are in regular hold'em!

Finally, players being dealt a third hole card instead of there being a fifth community card obviously affects hand values as well, making it even more likely that players improve their hands — yet another factor that has to be taken into account when calculating odds and considering your final-round betting strategy.

Conclusion

Short-deck poker / 6+ hold'em introduces several exciting twists to traditional Texas hold'em, creating an action-filled alternative that many players are finding especially enjoyable to play.

The changes from regular hold'em aren't terribly complicated, making it easy to new players to

learn and play right away.

Europa: Centristas luchan contra el populismo utilizando la cuestión de Ucrania

La campaña en Europa es más fácil para los populistas que para los centristas. Un solo término

impreso en letras grandes, como "diesel", es suficiente para que el partido alemán de extrema derecha Alternativa para Alemania (AfD) exprese su postura sobre el debate climático.

El electorado europeo moderno está tan enojado por tantas cosas, como el acuerdo verde, los migrantes, los automóviles eléctricos, la diversidad cultural, los mercados abiertos, Europa y la política en sí misma, que es difícil para los centristas encontrar un punto de apoyo.

Sin embargo, en vísperas de las elecciones al Parlamento Europeo, que se celebrarán del 6 al 9 de junio, Ucrania y las implicaciones de una amenaza rusa se han convertido en un tema para que los centristas lo aprovechen al enfrentar el desafío populista de izquierda y derecha.

Puede parecer un punto de reunión artificial: 512 miembros del Parlamento Europeo saliente votaron a favor del último paquete de ayuda para Ucrania y solo 45 en contra, con 63 abstenciones. Pero las conexiones entre los intereses de Moscú y los partidos de extrema derecha, especialmente aquellos partidos en el grupo del Parlamento Europeo Identidad y Democracia (ID), se ven como una veta rica.

Alemania como ejemplo

En Alemania, por ejemplo, el AfD, recientemente expulsado del grupo ID, ha estado presionando por la reapertura del Nord Stream 2. En el otro extremo del espectro político, el nuevo partido nacionalista liderado por la carismática política Sahra Wagenknecht también se opone a las armas para Ucrania.

Por un lado, el centro político no tiene otra opción que luchar contra este tipo de argumentos. Pero también siente una oportunidad: la simpatía por Kiev sigue siendo fuerte y el tema tiene la capacidad de dividir a la derecha extrema.

El presidente francés, en particular, ha hecho de Ucrania un punto de reunión para derrotar al populismo, convirtiéndolo en el tema central del lanzamiento de la campaña en Lille.

Hablando en Berlín, y claramente pensando en Marine Le Pen, Emmanuel Macron dijo: "En todos nuestros países hay falsos pacifistas en Europa, personas que dicen: 'estamos a favor de detenerlo inmediatamente'. Además, si seguimos la voz del presidente ruso, él va por el mundo diciendo: 'Estoy a favor de la paz si todavía entregan los territorios que invadí por la fuerza'. Eso no es paz. Esto no es nuestra visión de la paz. Lo he vuelto a decir una y otra vez, la paz solo puede ser duradera y, por lo tanto, en cumplimiento del derecho internacional."

Las credenciales de Macron como azote del imperialismo ruso pueden ser cuestionadas. De hecho, François Ruffin, un diputado de La France Insoumise, ha argumentado: "No tenemos lecciones que aprender de un hombre que acogió a Vladimir Putin en Versalles y en Fort Brégançon, cuando Crimea ya había sido invadida, Anna Politkovskaya y otros opositores asesinados."

Pero Macron ha duplicado esfuerzos. Con el telón de fondo simbólico de los aniversarios del Día D este mes, discutirá con Volodymyr Zelenskiy planes para que los entrenadores franceses operen dentro de Ucrania para ayudar a liberar el país.

Macron no es el único líder europeo que se apoya en Ucrania para galvanizar a su base. A lo largo de Europa, de diferentes maneras y en diferentes grados, Ucrania se ha convertido en una línea divisoria en estas elecciones, con la esperanza de que sea el talón de Aquiles de los populistas.
